Information clause

According to the General Data Protection Regulation of 27 April 2016 hereafter referred to as GDPR, the University of Gdańsk would like to inform you that:

1) The administrator of your personal data is the University of Gdansk with its seat in (80-309) Gdansk, 8 Jana Bażyńskiego Street.

2) The Administrator has appointed a Data Protection Officer, who can be contacted at telephone number (58) 523 31 30 or e-mail address: iod@ug.edu.pl.

The Data Protection Officer may be contacted in all matters regarding the processing of personal data and exercising rights connected with the processing.

3) Your personal data will be processed in order to carry out the recruitment process for the scientific-technical staff position and in the case of positive conclusion of the recruitment process – also for employment purposes.

4) The legal basis for the processing of your personal data for the purposes of recruitment is Article

6(1)(a) of the GDPR - consent of the data subject, and in the case of employment also Article 6(1)(b) of the GDPR - processing is necessary for the performance of a contract to which the data subject is a party, or to take action at the request of the data subject before entering into a contract.

5) Your personal data will be processed on behalf of the controller by authorised personnel solely for the purposes referred to in point 3.

6) Your personal data will not be shared with external entities, except in cases provided by law. Moreover, recipients of your personal data can be Managing, Accounting, Intermediate Bodies, Monitoring, Controlling, Implementing or Project Partners.
